

The following deed of conveyance from Carter Tarrant to Philip Evans being proven before Robert Maxwell Esq by the oath of Ambrose Blackburn was presented and recorded this fifth day of August 1795.

This Indenture <sup>made</sup> this fiftenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four between Carter Tarrant of the one part & Philip Evans of the other part Witnesseth that the said Carter Tarrant for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & forty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents by the S. Philip Evans the receipt thereof by the said Carter Tarrant hereby Acknowledged have granted Bargained sold released and confirmed and by the presents
