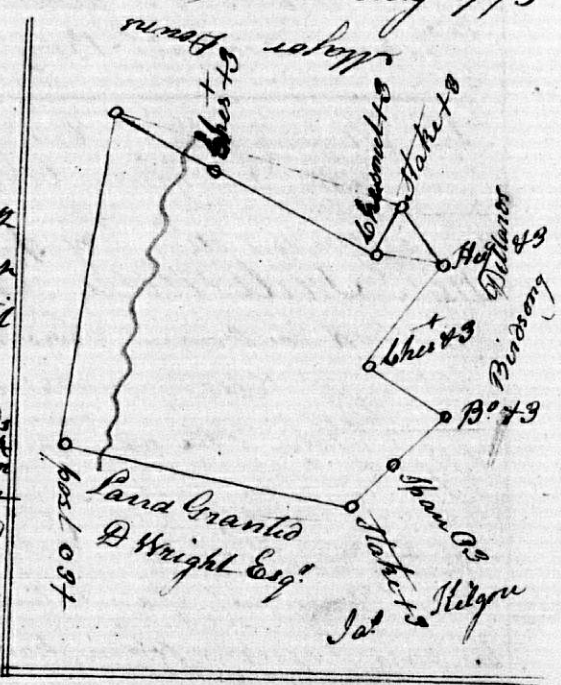


148 The following deed of Conveyance from Joseph Woolbanks to Daniel Woolbanks being proven before John Thomas Jun<sup>r</sup> Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of James Kilgore was presented & recorded 12<sup>th</sup> Aug. 1795

State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina Greenville County This Indenture made this 11<sup>th</sup> Day of October one thousand seven hundred ninety four and in the nineteenth year of the independence of the united States between Joseph Woolbanks of the one part Daniel Wilbanks of the other part witnesseth that for & in consideration of five pounds lawful money to him in hand paid by Daniel Wilbanks to Joseph Woolbanks the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that



Joseph Woolbanks hath bargained sold & by these presents doth Bargain & sell & confirm unto the s<sup>d</sup> Daniel Wilbanks all that tract of or parcels of Land containing one hundred & eighty Acres more or less having such shapes marks form & buttings as the above plat represents it being a part of Tract of seven hundred & three Acres of Land granted to Nicholas White the 7<sup>th</sup> Day of January 1793 & s<sup>d</sup> Joseph Woolbanks doth warrant & agree to & with s<sup>d</sup> Daniel Wilbanks that he will forever warrant & defend the above Described Land with its appurtenances or profits there unto belonging or in any wise thereto or of retaining from himself his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns & no further unto the s<sup>d</sup> Daniel Wilbanks he his heirs or assigns in writing Witness the s<sup>d</sup> Joseph Woolbanks hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the Day & date first above Written

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The following Deed of Conveyance from Christopher Brunk to William Stone being proven before Humphrey Cobb Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Robert Hamner was presented & recorded this 12<sup>th</sup> Day of August D. 1795 This Indenture made the twenty first Day of March one thousand seven hundred & ninety five, between Christopher Brunk, of Greenville County, South Carolina, of the one part, & William Stone Jun<sup>r</sup> of the County & State afores<sup>d</sup>, of the other part, witnesseth, that the s<sup>d</sup> Christopher Brunk, for & in Consideration of One hundred Pounds Sterling, to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the s<sup>d</sup> Brunk hath granted bargained sold alligned & Enfeoffed Released & confirmed & by these presents doth grant Bargain sell Alien Enfeoff Release & confirm unto the s<sup>d</sup> William Stone Jun<sup>r</sup> a piece of Land containing one hundred & fifty Acres more or less lying in the County aforesaid on the waters of the branch of the South Carolina River Beginning at Brunk's point
