

To the beginning mapel corner all supposed to be one Hundred Acres of land
All situated on the North side Durbins Creek And Frontier the S^r John
Wilson For himself his heirs Executors and adm^r. Dth convenient
I agree to and with Richard Jones his heirs Executors adm^r. &
Assigns that above described Land is clear from all manner of In-
cumbrance whatever & the S^r Richard Jones he his heirs or assigns
may at any time and and at all times possible possess & enjoy
the above mentioned Land with all its profits & Appurtenance
There unto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereunto without
any Denial of him the S^r John Wilson his heirs Executors adm^r.

son or persons whatsoever in Witness Whereof the S^r John Wilson

The following Deed of Conveyance from William Miller to James
Brasher being proven before Reuben Barrett Esq^r by the oath of
Thomas Edwards was presented & recorded this 25th Jan^y 1796

This Indenture made this first Day of August in the year
of our Lord 1795 & seventh year of American Independancy
between ^{Wm} Miller of the County of Greenville & State of South
Carolina of the one part & James Brasher of S^c County & State
of the other Whereas the said Miller did obtain a grant as
his at law to Whit's Miller from under the hand of his Excell
ency William M^r the Esq^r Governour & Commander in Chief
