


Appertainings & all other the premises herely granted bargained ^{Mentioned} & sold or

The following Dec^r from Samuel Magness to Charles Benson being
 proven before S^r B. Blackwell by the oath of George A. Hinder was
 presented & Recorded this 28th day of January 1859

This Indenture made the 19th of September in the year of our lord one thousand seven
 hundred & ninety five between Samuel Magness of Granville County &
 State of South Carolina & Charles Benson of the County & State aforesaid
 witnesseth that whereas in & by part of a certain Grant bearing date the
 5th Day of June one thousand seven hundred & eighty six from under
 the hand of William Miller Esq^r Governor at that time did give &
 Grant unto James Mabelory a tract of land containing 609 acres
 Situate in the County and State above mentioned bounded by upon a small
 branch of rocky river & on the north side of rocky river including the west side
 of Paris mountain having such forms & shape & marks as are repre-
 sented by a plat which plat & Grant being duly recorded in the Secretarys
 Office witnesseth that the S^r Samuel Magness for & in consideration of the
 Sum of 50 pound Sterling money to him in hand paid by the S^r
 Charles Benson the receipt whereof he the S^r Samuel Magness doth
 here by acknowledge hath bargained granted & sold & doth by the
 presents Grant bargain sell unto the S^r Charles Benson his heirs
 Executors or assigns 100 acres of the above mentioned Land more or
 less which boundaries & lines as follows Conditional line which is
 as run by them the S^r Samuel Magness & Charles Benson
 beginning on David Brooks line & running thence to a stone ridge
