The following deed of Conveyance from Thomas Revil to George Russell being proven before Rob<sup>t</sup> M<sup>o</sup>se Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Lewis Reiter was presented and recorded this 6<sup>th</sup> day of April A<sup>d</sup> 1796

This Indenture made the eleventh day of sept<sup>r</sup> in the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety two and in the sixteenth year of American Independance between Thomas Revil of the State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina Laurens County planter of the one part, and George Russell of the s<sup>t</sup> State & County of Greenville of the other part Whereas in and by a certain grant bearing date the third day of March in the year one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight from and the hand of Thomas Pinckney Esq<sup>r</sup> then Lieu<sup>t</sup> Governor & Commander in chief of the said State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina and the great seal of the State for that purpose appointed did give and Grant unto Thomas Revil a plantation or Tract of seven hundred and fifty acres of Land on a creek called Brushy Creek the waters of Enoree River, having such shape form & marks as a plat to the s<sup>d</sup> Grant annexed represents the s<sup>d</sup> Grant being duly recorded in the Secretaries Office for the time being in Grant Book W. W. W. W. page 811 reference to s<sup>d</sup> Record fully appear Now this Indenture witnesseth that the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Revil for & in consideration of ~~that~~ pounds to him in hand paid by the s<sup>r</sup> George Russell the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged he the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Revil hath bargained sold ~~remised~~, released and conveyed & confirmed, and by these presents doth bargain sell, remise, release, convey and confirm unto the s<sup>r</sup> George Russell five hundred acres being part of the s<sup>d</sup> Tract of seven hundred & fifty acres, beginning on Pucket's old line including all the s<sup>d</sup> Tract of land Southwards of s<sup>d</sup> Pucket's line except a corner laid out to William Dempsey the s<sup>d</sup> Tract being supposed to contain five hundred acres by the same more or less by it left Together with all and singular the houses, buildings, barns, Stables, Gardens, orchards, Trees, woods, waters, water Courses, or whatsoever may be thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining without the least reserve whatsoever & the said George Russell his heirs Ex<sup>ts</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or assigns or any from or under the Authority of the s<sup>r</sup> George Russell shall and may from time to time & at all times whatsoever agreeable to his or their own will & pleasure have hold use occupy and enjoy the s<sup>d</sup> Tract or part of the s<sup>d</sup> Tract of seven hundred & fifty acres supposed to contain five hundred acres by the same more or be it less without any manner of hindrance trouble Molestation Interruption or denial of him the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Revil his heirs Ex<sup>ts</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or assigns or of any other person or persons whatsoever and lastly the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Revil from himself his heirs Ex<sup>ts</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or assigns or from any other person or persons whatsoever the s<sup>d</sup> Tract of five hundred acres as aforesaid unto the s<sup>r</sup> George Russell his heirs Ex<sup>ts</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or assigns shall and will warrant and for ever defend In witness whereof the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas
