The following Deed of Conveyance from Solomon Langston to Joab Smith being proven before Robert Mape Esq^r by the oath of Thomas Edwards was presented and recorded this 16th April 1796

State of South Carolina Know all men by presents that I Solomon Langston of Laurens County in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds to me in hand paid by Joab Smith son of Aaron Smith of Greenville County in the said State have granted bargained and sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Joab Smith all that Tract of land whereon John Dodd formerly lived including one hundred acres with the houses & Improvements to be laid off as is most suitable it being part of a survey of six hundred and forty acres conveyed from James Langston to Solomon Langston as the records of Greenville Court will make appear, also there is nothing in this conveyance to deprive Sarah Dodd of the advantages nor possession of that Land during her life together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the S^r. premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joab Smith his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs my heirs & to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the S^r. premises unto the said Joab Smith his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand & Seal this 22 day of January in the year of our Lord 1796 & in the Twentieth year of the Independency of the United States of America
