The following deed of Conveyance from Alexander Ray to William Whaley being proven before John Thomas Jun^r Esq^r by the oath of William Thomas was presented and recorded this 22nd day of April 1796

This Indenture made the twenty first day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three between Alexander Ray of the state of South Carolina & County of Spartanburg of the one part & William Whaley of the state aforesaid & Greenville County of the other part Witnesseth that the s^d Alexander Ray for and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds current Money to him in hand paid by the said William Whaley at and before the signing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged themselves therewith fully satisfied hath granted bargained & sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell alien convey & confirm unto the s^d William Whaley his heirs & assigns all that tract or parcel of Land situate in the State aforesaid in Greenville County on the South Side of the South fork of Sugar River on a small bank of said River bounded by a line running SW by John Stiles Land SE by Alexander Rays Land NE by Vacant Land or near Robert Nelsons Land containing nineteen Acres the same being Granted unto the s^d Alexander Ray by Grant dated second day of February 1789 with the great seal of said State thereunto affixed signed Charles Pinckney Governor of said State & all trees woods under woods & other commons common of pasture profits common stiles & advantages hereditaments ways waters & appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in any way appertaining and also the reversion and reversions remainder & Remainders Rents & services of the said premises and every part thereof & the estate right title Interest claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Alexander Ray of in & to the said tract of Land & premises and every part thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and all and singular the premises above mentioned and every part & parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the s^d William Whaley his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said William Whaley his heirs and assigns for ever & the said Alexander Ray for him & his heirs the said tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part thereof against him & his heirs and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever to the said William Whaley his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents.
