Jointly, severally, firmly by these presents sealed with our seals & dated this fifth day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety five — — Whereas the above named Larkin Farrant was duly appointed Sheriff by the Judges of the said County of Greenville, pursuant to the directions laid down in the County Court Law — Now the condition of the above obligation is such, that if the S<sup>r</sup> Larkin Farrant shall & do well and truly execute the Office of Sheriff for & during the Term of four years as Specified & required by his commission signed by the Governor of s<sup>t</sup> State bearing date the fifth day of February, without fraud, then the above obligation to be void else to remain in full force and virtue

The following deed of Conveyance from Gadock Ford to Edward Mitcherson being proven before William Mitcherson Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Holloway Power was presented & recorded this 26<sup>th</sup> June 1796

This Indenture made this the fourth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety five & in the twentieth year of America's Independency between Gadock Ford of the State of South Carolina Spartanburgh County of the one part & Edward Mitcherson
