 73 to a post oak on John Brandon land thence S. 35 W. 88 48 to a white  
 oak on vacant land, thence S. 5 38 40 to the beginning together with all and  
 singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said  
 premises belonging or in any wise incidental or appertaining to have & to  
 hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
 John Staten Sen<sup>r</sup> his heirs and assigns for ever, & I do hereby bind myself  
 my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & for ever defend all  
 and singular the said premises unto the said John Staten this here  
 and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person  
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
 as witness my hand & Seal this 9<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six in the twenty first  
 year of America Independence (Inscribed before signed)

The following Deed of Gift from Patrick Daly to James Daly being  
 proven before Reuben Barrett Esq. by the oath of Joseph Dale Sen<sup>r</sup> was  
 presented and Recorded this 11<sup>th</sup> day of August 1796  
 To all people to whom these presents shall come I Patrick Daly do send  
 Greeting; Know ye that I the said Patrick Daly of the District of  
 Washington in the County of Greenville State of S. Carolina Labourer  
 for and in consideration of the love good will & affection which I have  
 and do bear towards my loving & dutiful son James Daly of the same  
 District and County aforesaid (School Master) have given & granted  
 and by these presents do freely and clearly give & grant unto my  
 said loving son viz, James Daly this heirs & assigns one  
 moiety or half of a certain tract or parcel of land containing by es-  
 timation Two hundred Sixty acres situate lying & being in the District  
 County State aforesaid & on Foderberrys Beaver dam creek waters of  
 Sugar river beginning at a hewn corner Tree & running N. 67. W.  
 87-50 to a black gum corner tree thence S. 70 W. 28-50 to a white corner  
 thence S. 10 E. 12 chs to a spanish Oak corner tree thence S. 70 E. 28 chs to a  
 red oak corner tree thence S. 30 E. 14 chs 26 lts to a red oak corner tree  
 thence N. 80 E. 31 20 lts to a post oak corner tree thence S. 70 W. 28 chs  
 to a red oak corner tree thence N. 70 W. 28 chs to a black gum corner tree
