

300 The following deed of Conveyance from John Ashmore to Benjamin Jones being, proven before James Hilgou Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of W<sup>m</sup> Richardson was presented & recorded this 9<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1796

This Indenture made this Twenty eighth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety six between John Ashmore of the State of South Carolina Greenville County of the one part, & Benjamin Jones of the State and County aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth that the said John Ashmore for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty pounds lawful Sterling Money to him in hand paid at & before the sealing, and delivering of these presents by the said Benjamin Jones the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged, has given granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed, and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto him the said Benjamin Jones him his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Greenville and on Rock Creek and Reedy River it being a part of a tract of land vested in William Stone by virtue of a deed of conveyance made to the said William Stone by N. canon Hudson bearing date on the Twelfth day of January one thousand seven hundred and ninety three, which said land was made to the said Hudson by James Harrison bearing date on the tenth day of September one thousand seven hundred and ninety two reference therunto will more fully appear also it being a part of land vested in William Stone by virtue of a deed conveyance made by Lewis Devall to N. canon Hudson bearing date on the ninth day of March 1788 which Hudson made over to said William Stone bearing date the Twelfth day of January 1798 reference will more fully appear by a grant from under the hand and seal of William Moultrie Esquire Governor over the State of S. Carolina at that time bearing date the sixth day of November 1786 containing 400 acres of land, the land to be conveyed begins on a forked Red oak Corner on the North bank of reedy River it being a corner old Marked between said N. canon Hudson and John Brasher and runs N. E. on a line Marked between said Hudson and John Brasher to a pine corner thence on a new marked line between William and John Ashmore and the land now to be conveyed said line running S. E. across Rock Creek in all 57 chains to Samuel Steels line thence by the waggon Road thence on S. Steels line S 89 N 8 chains to a white oak corner on the north branch of said Rock Creek, thence S. on said Steels line to where it runs to Reedy River and bounding on the west bank of said reedy river to the beginning corner with all
