 Hodgson being proven before John McElroy Esq. by the oath of
 John White was presented and Recorded this 13th day of Jan^y 1797

State of S. Carolina, I know all men by these presents that I
 Greenville County & Larkin Tarrant of the County & State aforesaid
 for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds Ster-
 ling Money of the State aforesaid to me in hand paid by William
 Tatham Hodgson of the County & State aforesaid have granted bargain'd
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release
 unto William Tatham Hodgson all that plantation or tract of land
 containing three hundred & thirteen acres more or less lying on both
 sides of a Branch of the Golden Goose Creek Granted the 21st January
 1785 to Samuel Foster conveyed from Foster to Ulrich Conner &
 Recorded in Spartanburgh Office from Ulrich Conner to James Seaborn
 & from Seaborn to Larkin Tarrant bounded W. & N.W. by John Tarrant
 land E. & S. East by James Southern land E. S. E. by George Seaborn's land
 & by John Whites land Together with all and singular the members & in-
 cidements & appurtenances to the s^d premises belonging or in any wise
 Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the pre-
 mises before mentioned unto the said William Tatham Hodgson his
 heirs and assigns for ever, & I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors
 & Administrators to warrant & for ever defend all & singular the s^d
 premises unto William T. Hodgson his heirs & assigns against myself
 and my Heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming
 or to claim the same or any part thereof - witness my hand & Seal
 this 30th September 1796 & the 21st year of the American Independence
