320 The following deed of Conveyance from Henry Clark to Edward Ware being proven before Reuben Barretto Esq. by the oath of James Ret- lar was presented and recorded this 14th day of January 1797
This Indenture made this second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety five in the Twentieth year of the American Independency between Henry Clark of the County of Greenville State of South Carolina of the one part & Edward Ware of the same place of the other part witnesseth that the said Henry Clark for in consideration of the sum of sixty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Ware the receipt whereof he the S. Clark doth acknowledge himself fully satisfied and paid, by these presents hath given granted bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed conveyed and confirmed unto him the said Edward Ware a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Greenville on Naughans Creek of North Piedmonte river containing by estimation one hundred & thirty four acres including the place where the S. Ware now lives bounded as follows beginning at a red oak and runs thence S 60 E 18 chains to a stake & thence S 35 chains to a stake thence N 61 W 50 chains to a stake thence N 20 W 29 chains to a stake thence S 86 E 35 chains & fifty links to the beginning red oak containing by estimation one hundred & thirty four acres be the same more or less it being a tract of land patented by the S. Clark bearing date the fourth day of February 1793 know us ye that I the S. Henry Clark for myself my heirs Executors Administrators & assigns and from every other person or persons do promise to warrant & for ever defend the above mentioned land & premises to him the S. Edward Ware his heirs and assigns for ever against the lawful claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever In witness whereof he the S.
