South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I James Maxwell of Greenville County in consideration of the sum of Twenty eight pounds to me paid by John Little of the County afores^d have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said John Little all that tract or parcel of land laying & being in the S^c County on Elisha Thompsons Beaver Dam creek beginning at a poplar Station near a branch & running thence S^o 60^o W^t to and oak thence N^o 30^o W^t of ^{the} 50^o to and oak thence N^o 58^o E^t 20 ch^o to a stake, thence N^o 74^o E^t to Beaver dam creek, thence down the meanders of said Creek to the mouth of the first branch on the S^c Side of said creek thence up the meanders of said Branch to the beginning containing one hundred and forty acres be the same more or less the same being part of a tract of land granted by Patent to James Maxwell bearing date 7th day of April 1788 together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appurtenant to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Little his heirs & assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Little his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

The following Deed of Conveyance from Thomas Jones to Edward Howard and being proven before James Milgou Esq. by the oath of John Howard was presented & Recorded this 6th day of April A^d 1797

This Indenture made this twenty ninth day of October 1796 between Thomas Jones of the State of South Carolina, Greenville County of the one part & Edw^d. Howard of the State & County afores^d of the other part witnesses that the s^d. Thomas Jones for & in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds lawful money to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained & sold and by these presents doth bargain & sell release & confirm unto Edw^d. Howard for ever all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred & ninety six acres it being a part of a tract 268 acres Originally granted to s^d. Thomas Jones by Patent bearing date the 10th day of July 1791 & recorded in Grant Book B^o 162 N^o 5
