The following deed of Conveyance from Samuel Neighbours & Rebecca Neighbours to Burwell Carpenter being proven before Tho. Camp Esq. by the oath of John Neighbours was presented & Recorded this 17th day of April 1797
 State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that we Samuel Neighbours and Rebecca Neighbours his wife of Laurence County & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds sterling good and lawful money of South Carolina to them in hand paid by Burwell Carpenter of Abbeville County & State aforesaid hath granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Burwell Carpenter a plantation or tract of land situate in Greenville County on Little horse Creek beginning at a stake on John Hayes line and running thence East on the said line to a corner on a red oak on the meeting House branch, thence up the said Branch to a stake corner, thence West to a red oak corner on Hollons line thence North with said line to a red oak corner, thence South with the said Hollons line to a sassafras stake, thence North East on Joseph Hills line to the beginning, containing two hundred acres more or less of land & being part of a tract of nine hundred and ninety six acres of land granted to Samuel Neighbours by Thomas Pinckney Governor and commander in chief in and over the said State at ~~the~~ the fifth day of January one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine and recorded in grant Book Y Y Y Y page 347 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Burwell Carpenter his heirs and assigns for ever, and we hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said plantation or tract of land containing two hundred acres more or less of land unto the said Burwell Carpenter his heirs and assigns against ourselves our heirs and every other person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by from or under him her them or any of them in witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seal this 27 day of ~~the~~
