

 The following Deed of Conveyance from James White to James Kilgore being proven before William Hutchinson Esq^r by the oath of John Kilgore was presented and Recorded this 20th day of April 1797
 This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of May one thousand seven hundred and ninety four between James White of the State of South Carolina Orangeburgh District of the one part, and James Kilgore of Greenville County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of five hundred pounds lawful money in hand paid to the said James White by James Kilgore the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said James White hath bargained and sold unto by these presents doth bargain sell alien and conform unto James Kilgore all that tract of land including six hundred and fifty acres the same being granted to James White by Peter Loring date the twenty sixth day of August 1774, and hath such Shape form Bounding and boundings as will appear by a plat annexed to said grant the grant being for eight hundred acres said White having heretofore conveyed a part of said 800 acre tract to Nathaniel Newman which includes the plantation where Henry Brockmon now lies supposed to be one hundred and fifty acres the balance included in said 800 acre survey bounding on the S^t side of Enoree river on Joseph Hollbanks, John Clegg, Benjamin Kilgore Senior & Benjamin Kilgore Junior lands and James Kilgore's land Originally granted to Moses White, also including the plantation where said James Kilgore now lies also the plantation where John Clegg now lies an almost situation both sides of Clemen & Peters creeks is the land to be conveyed from said James White to James Kilgore by the same more or less as the said James White for himself his heirs executors & Administrators doth command and agree to and with the said James Kilgore that he the said James Kilgore & his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns or either of them may from time to time and at all times hereafter peaceably possess and enjoy all and every part of the above described land with all its appurtenances thereunto belonging to James
