

391 The following deed of conveyance from Absalom Greener to William Dandy being proven before John M. Elroy Esq. by the oath of Augustin Sims was presented and recorded this 8<sup>th</sup> day of June 1797

South Carolina, By Absalom Greener Administrator on the Estate of James Floyd deceased, Know all men by these presents that I Absalom Greener, of the State of South Carolina & Greenville County in consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds paid by William Dandy of said County & State have granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said William Dandy that part of a Tract of land Originally granted to James Floyd & signed by Governor Moutrie on the fourth day of December one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six beginning where a line of the Original survey crosses Cabin Branch being a branch of Reedy river in the County aforesaid thence along said line East 27 chains to a light wood Stake & thence N E 15° 19' 50" to a post of Stake & thence East 19 to a rod of Stake & thence N 60° W 78 to a rod of Stake & thence S W 30-6 to a rod of Stake & thence S 70 E 9 to a Stake & thence S 15° E 6-32 to a Stake & thence N E 69 12-26 to a small ash Stake; in the said branch, thence down the said branch with its meanders to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Dandy his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Dandy his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this twenty second day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, so far only as an Administrator can be bound by Law.

391 The following Deed of Conveyance from Wm Thomas & Job Cochran to Joseph Davis being proven before John Thomas Junr Esq. by the oath of James Edington was presented and Recorded this 8<sup>th</sup> day of June 1797

This Indenture made the fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six, between William Thomas & Job Cochran of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part, and Joseph Davis of the County & State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said William Thomas & Job Cochran for and in consideration of the sum of forty pounds of money then in hand paid
