 River and having such form and marks as appears by a plat to the
 said grant annexed Together with all and singular the houses buildings
 Orchards meadows Trees woods waters passages hereditaments and
 appurtenances whatsoever to the said land belonging or any wise ap-
 partaining and the reversion and reversions, remainder & Remainders
 rents Issues and profits thereof to have and to hold the said tract of
 five hundred acres (except as before excepted) with all and every the
 premises thereto belonging to the said Joseph Davis his heirs & his
 Administrators and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of him
 the said Joseph Davis his heirs and assigns for ever and the said
 William Thomas & Job Cochran their heirs and assigns against them
 their heirs Executors Administrators & assigns and against all other
 person or persons the above bargained premises will warrant and

 ration of the sum of Twenty two pounds Sterling money of the State afo-
 said to him in hand by him the said George Elliott at and before the
 sealing of these presents the receipt whereof him the said James Floyd
 doth hereby acknowledge himself therewith fully satisfied & paid
 hath given granted bargained & sold aliened conveyed & confirmed
