


The following Deed of Conveyance from John Rodgers to Hugh Roark being proven before Jesse Carter by the oath of George Green was presented and recorded this 10th June 1797

The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John Rodgers of Greenville County State of South Carolina Blacksmith in consideration of one hundred pounds Sterling money of the State aforesaid to me paid by Hugh Roark of the County State aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Hugh Roark all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred & thirty four acres be the same more or less situated lying & being in the County State aforesaid and on both sides of Brushy Creek waters of Reedy River beginning on a post oak running thence S. 13 W. 12 ch^s to a post oak corner & to thence S. 5 W. 26-00 to a stake corner & to thence S. 71 E. 9-00 to a pine corner & to thence S. 40 W. 44-60 to a Black Jack corner & to thence N. 3 W. 56-00 to a post in a mountain & to thence N. 6 E. 34-00 to the beginning, the same being part of two Grants one of which being Originally granted to Charles Custie on the fifth day of August 1793 the other part Originally granted to Jeremiah Chandler on the sixth day of October 1788 references being had to the said Grants may more fully & at large appear Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Hugh Roark his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & for ever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Hugh Roark his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand & Seal this fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety six & in the twelfth year of the Independance of the United States of America
