The following Deed of Conveyance from Abraham Hudson to William Mason
 being proven before David Goodlett Esq. by the oath of Robert Mason
 was presented and recorded this 13th June 1797
 This Indenture made this twelfth day of October in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six and of
 the Independency of the United States of America the twenty first
 between Abraham Hudson of the State of South Carolina and County
 of Greenville of the one part, and William Mason of the County &
 State afores^d of the other part witnesseth for and in consideration of the
 sum of ten pounds Sterling lawful Money of S. State in paid by W. Mason
 hath bargained sold and by these presents doth bargain sell & make
 over unto William Mason certain plantation or Tract of land containing
 one hundred acres more or less lying in Greenville County on Rocky Creek
 of Enoree river and hath such boundries whereas it begining on a
 red oak on Luns^d Hudson line thence running north to a spanish Oak &
 from thence to the Creek, and thence running up said Creek to the fork &
 from thence up the north fork to the dividing line made between Ab^m
 Hudson & Luns^d Hudson from thence running along S. line to a white oak
 corner from thence to the beginning boundie East and north by Ab^m
 Hudsons land and W. South on Luns^d Hudsons land it being apart of a Tract
 of land containing three hundred acres granted to Abraham Hudson & a part
 of a Tract of land containing 983 acres granted to ^{Luns^d} Abraham Hudson he hath
 granted bargained sold, and by these presents doth bargain sell & convey
