The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Merideth Blackburn of Greenville County and State aforesaid in consideration of six pounds Sterling to me in hand paid by John Ware of the same place have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Ware his heirs and assigns for ever all that parcel or tract of land Situate in the County aforesaid on the waters of the Golden Grove being part of a Tract of land Originally Granted to Merideth Blackburn by his Excellency William Moultrie Governor on the first day of May one thousand seven hundred and eighty six reference being had to the Original Grant will more fully appear beginning on a ~~whichever~~ corner of S. Original line running thence South East to open on another line of the same Original Survey, conditional thence along said line S 88 45 54 to whichever corner on S. line thence N 45 25 50 to the beginning containing by computation thirty acres more or less Together with all and singular the members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said John Ware his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Ware his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand seal this thirtieth day of April Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven, Present
