The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above
bound Joseph Nawn his heirs or assigns doth make or cause to be
made unto the said Joseph Ferry his heirs or assigns a lawful
right & title to the one half of the plantation on which they both
now live (the lower end) as soon as he can get a lawful right him-
self that then the above obligation to be void and of no effect
otherwise to remain in full force & virtue given under my hand

of the County of Berkeley in the State of Virginia have for divers good
considerations nominated constituted and appointed and by these
presents do nominate constitute and appoint & in my stead and
place deputy Mr. Thomas Beale of Fineastle in Botetourt County
of the said State my true and lawful Attorney for me and in
my name to enter into one thousand acres of land, situate in the
district of ninety six in the State of South Carolina Admeasured
and laid out unto Jacob O'Bannon late in two different
plantations or Tracts of land of five hundred acres each having
such form and marks bollings and boundings as the different
plots annexed to the different grants of the said State of South
Carolina in pursuance and by virtue of an Ordinance of the said
State shew and exhibe; and also to enter into two thousand acres
of land in the said District of South Carolina admeasured and
laid out unto George Hite in four different plantations in manner
aforesaid and by virtue of the Ordinance aforesaid; and the said
lands or any part thereof for me and in my name to bargain &
Sell by Indenture or otherwise for me & in my name to give & so as to
