The following Deed of Conveyance from Jesse Chandler ^{honor} to Larkin Tar-
 rant being proven before Horatia Griffin Esq. by the oath of William
 Wood was presented and Recorded this 4th day of September 1797
 This Indenture made this twenty Eighth day of December in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between Jesse
 Chandler of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the
 one part & Larkin Tarrant Esq. of the said State and County of the
 other part, witnesseth that the said Jesse Chandler for the consid-
 ration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling Money to him in hand
 paid by the said Larkin Tarrant at and before the sealing & delivery of these
 presents the receipt whereof the said Jesse Chandler doth hereby acknow-
 ledge, have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed
 unto the said Larkin Tarrant his heirs and assigns for ever part of that
 plantation or Tract of land lying and being in Greenville County on the
 S^o of N^o Fork of Brush Creek of Reedy River containing three hundred
 acres being part of a Tract of land Originally granted unto the said
 Jesse Chandler and Signed by his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq. on
 the sixth day of August one thousand seven hundred and ninety two as by
 a plat annexed to the S^o Grant will more fully appear being admeasured
 and laid out to the said Larkin Tarrant as follows beginning at a red oak
 on the side of the Creek, thence N^o 58 E 44 chain to a maple near the N^o fork
 of Brush Creek, thence S^o 92 E 15 chain to a stake thence N^o 4 E 21 chain to
 post oak, thence N 80 W 10 chain to Black oak, thence N 10 W 10 chain to
 a stake, thence S 58 E 46 chain Hickory, thence S 26 W 24 chain to Stake, thence to the
 beginning containing three hundred acres Together with all and singular
 the Houses waters Trees fences hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever
 to the said Tract of land so described as above belonging or in any wise
 appertaining, and the reversion and reversions remainder and remain-
