440 The following deed of Conveyance from James Copland to Archer  
Holcombe being proven before Reuben Barrett Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of  
David Johnston was presented & recorded this 15<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1797

This Indenture this seventeenth day of February in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven & in the nine-  
teenth year of American Independence between James Copland  
of the State of S. Carolina and Greenville County of the one part  
and Archer Holcombe of the State and County aforesaid of the  
other part witnesseth that whereas in and by certain Grant  
bearing date the Twenty first day of January in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty five under the hand of  
his Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esq<sup>r</sup> Governor and commander in  
chief in and over the said State having the great seal of the State  
thenunto officed did give and grant unto Archibald a certain Tract or  
parcel of land containing four hundred acres situate lying & being in  
the State aforesaid in Greenville County on the branch of South Tyar  
river called Jacks Creek having such shapes forms marks boundaries &  
boundings as are represented by a plat to the said Grant annexed which  
plat and Grant being duly recorded in the Secretarys Office of said  
State reference therunto had will more fully appear and by the said  
Archibald Dill on the thirtieth day of March in the year of our Lord  
one thousand seven hundred and ninety three conveyed by a deed of  
Conveyance to James Copland two hundred acres of the said Tract  
being the upper end of said Survey including the plantation whereon  
whereon the said James Copland Copland now lives the said Deed being  
Recorded in the Clerks Office of said County on the fourteenth of June  
one thousand seven hundred and ninety three reference therunto  
had will more fully appear, now this Indenture witnesseth  
that the said James Copland for and in consideration of the sum  
of three pound to him in hand well and Truly paid by the said Archer  
Holcombe at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents  
the use whereof is hereby acknowledged and of every part and  
person thereof do fully acquit exonerate and discharge him the said
