 Know all men by these presents that I Wilson Rodgers of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville have granted bargained sold and confirmed by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm unto William Rodgers of the County & State aforesaid for the consideration of Forty nine dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the following property that is to say two feather beds and furniture two dishes, thirteen plates & Two Basins, two pots, a double Oven Bone Skillet, one Butter pot, a pair of Smoothing Irons on chest to have and to hold the above mentioned Articles unto the said William Rodgers his heirs & assigns unto the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Rodgers his heirs and assigns for ever and the said Wilson Rodgers doth hereby for himself and his heirs for ever warrant and defend the above mentioned Articles against all and every other person or persons whatsoever claiming any right or Title therunto or any part thereof In witness whereof the said Wilson Rodgers hath hereunto set his hand and seal this Twenty first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of Test Isaac Bruice
