E. on Thomas Lowson du. & John Campbells line to the beginning being part of a tract of 400 acres of land Originally granted to Benjamin Arnold du. and bequeathed to his son Thomas Together with all and singular the rights and members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appurtening to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said David Franum his heirs and assigns for ever, and wth the said Thomas Arnold and Benjⁿ. Arnold do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Adm^{rs} to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said David Franum his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and every other person or persons whomsoever in witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals the day & date first above written. The following deed of Conveyance from James Southern to Money Southern being proven before Jesse Carter by the oath of John Macbeth was presented and recorded this 13th October 1797

The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that James Southern of the State of S^c Carolina & County of Greenville planter in the consideration of one hundred pounds Sterling money to me paid by Money Southern of the State and County aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold, & released, & by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said Money Southern all that plantation or part of a tract of land, situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid Originally granted unto William Wood, Beginning on a stake at a branch, running thence S. E. 45° 42 chains to a stake & thence S. W. 44° 30 ch. & 50 links to a stake & thence N. W. 45° 60 chains to a branch, thence up the various meanders of said branch to the beginning, containing two hundred acres more or less, Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise Incident or appurtening to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Money Southern his heirs and assigns for ever & do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant
