

The following deed of gift from James Southern to Nancy Southern being proven before Jesse Carter by the oath of John Maubeth was presented & Recorded this 18th day of October 1879

The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I James Southern of the State of S. Carolina & County of Greenville planter for and in consideration of the love, good will and Affection, which I have and do bear towards my loving daughter, Nancy Southern have given & granted, and by these presents doth freely and absolutely give and grant unto my said daughter Nancy Southern, all that plantation, or part of a Tract of land Situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid containing ninety acres more or less, Originally granted unto William Hood beginning on a stake on a Branch, running from thence N. 45 E. 36 chains to the old line to a stake 3x thence N. E. 44 5 ch. 50 links to a stake 3x on the old line, thence S. E. 45 20 chains to a stake 3x on the old line, thence S. E. 44 10 chains to a stake 3x on the old line, thence N. W. 45 60 chains to a branch, thence down the meander of said branch to the beginning. Also one feather Bed & furniture to have and to hold all and singular the property before mentioned unto my said Daughter Nancy Southern and to her heirs & assigns for ever, free and clear from all manner of Incumbrance whatsoever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the property as aforesaid unto my said daughter Nancy Southern her heirs Executors Administrators & assigns free from all manner of Condition whatsoever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety seven, & in the twenty second year of the Independance of the United States of America

The following deed of gift from Frederick Craft to Catherine, Elisabeth & Nancy Craft being proven before John McClellan Esq. by the oath of James Ashmore was presented and Recorded 29th Dec. 1879
To all whom it may concern Know ye that I Frederick Craft Sr. of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville for divers good causes and considerations mo therunto moving have given and by these presents do freely and of my own accord give unto my daughters Catherine Craft, Elisabeth Craft, Nancy Craft all and every part and parcel of my household furniture that I am now possessed with, also all my Stock of Cattle, meaning Black Cattle, Horses, sheep and hogs that I am now possessed of to be equally divided between them and as witness to the same I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 27th Decemb^r 1879
