The following deed of Conveyance from John Simmons to Richard Simmons being proven before Robert M. Coker Esq. by the oath of Murch Roberts was presented and recorded this 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 1798

This Indenture made this seventh day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between John Simmons of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part and Richard Simmons of the aforesaid County & State of the other part witnesseth that the said John Simmons for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said Richard Simmons the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said John Simmons hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain & sell to the said Richard Simmons his heirs and assigns for ever a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred acres lying and being on both sides of Mountain Branch of Enoree River beginning at a Stake on the North side of said Branch and running on Robert M. Coker's line S. 10° W. 27 to Mountain creek thence down S. Creek as it meanders to the mouth of a small branch on the South side of S. Creek a small distance above Richard Simmons field thence up said Branch to where the line of said Tract crosses thence with said line S. 80° E. 75 to an oak corner near to Richard Simmons Spring thence N. 8° 27 28 to a Stake thence N. 75-36 to the beginning the same Tract being originally granted to John Simons by Grant bearing date the first day of January one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven and signed by his Excellency William M. Patton it being the same whereon John Simmons now lives with said Tract of one hundred acres of Land with all and every right appurtenances the said John Simmons doth from himself and his heirs and from all other persons waive and
