The following deed of Conveyance from Richard Hooper to Thomas Hooper being proven before John Blackwell Esq. by the oath of Longston M^o Vay was presented and recorded this 16th January 1779

This Indenture made this Twentieth day of January one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven between Richard Hooper of the State of South Carolina and Pendleton County of the one part, and Thomas Hooper of the aforesaid State and County of Greenville of the other part witnesseth that s^r R Hooper for the consideration of the sum of Twelve pounds paid by the s^r Thomas Hooper the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and that s^r R Hooper have granted bargained and sold unto the s^r Tho^s Hooper a certain tract or parcel of land containing forty acres more or less beginning at a pine on W^m Woods line running along the s^r line to the head of Norepus Spring branch to adlake, thence down the S^r Branch to a conditional line laid out between Richard Hooper and Joseph Pearson over from thence to a white oak and from thence to the beginning and that the said Richard Hooper do warrant and forever defend the above mentioned Tract of land clear from the claim of any person to the s^r Tho^s Hooper in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day & date above mentioned
