

This Indenture made tenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and nine ty six under the twentieth first year of the Independence between James Hafford of the State of South Carolina Esq^r of the County of the one part and John Williams of Pendle to County and State aforesaid of the other part now this indenture Witnesseth when as in and by a certain Grant laid out for three hundred and twenty seven acres of Land dated the fourth day of July 1791 Situate in the district of nine ty six laying on the Branches of Corbans Creek the waters of Cno Bee River and hath such Shape and markes as are by a plat thereunto annexed and ~~ded~~ ^{ded} Sth by Rob^t Wilson Land and Nth Wth Sth Wth by W^m G^o G^o and all other sides by vacant Land now this indenture Witnesseth that the Said James Hafford for the consideration of the Sum of Twenty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the S^r John Williams the Receipt is here by acknowledged that he the said James Hafford is satisfied and paid and hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth Grant bargain and sell Release convey unto the said John Williams his heirs and assigns three hundred and twenty seven acres of Land as aforesaid together with all and singular the houses gardens orchards woods water courses hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the only use and behoof of him the S^r John Williams his heirs and assigns and he the S^r John Williams his heirs Executors administrators or assigns shall and may from time to time and at all times hereafter have hold use occupy possess and enjoy the said plantation or tract of three hundred and twenty seven acres of Land as aforesaid without any manner of trouble hindrance or molestation ^{interruption} or denial of him the said James Hafford him his heirs Executors administrators or assigns forever in Witness whereof the said James Hafford have to these presents set my hand and seal the day and date first above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of
