 The following Deed of Conveyance from Hugh Nelson to Isaac Stevens being sworn before Reuben Barnett by the oath of Robert Nelson was presented and Recorded this 29th Day of June 1798
 This indenture made this 14th Day of May 1796 & in the twenty sixth year of American Independence between Hugh Nelson of the State of South Carolina & Pendleton County of the one part and Isaac Stevens of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid of the other part where as in and by a certain grant bearing date the second day of May 1794 under the hand of his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esq. Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the said State have the great seal of the said State thereunto affixed did give & grant unto Hugh Nelson a tract of Land containing 12.7 acres situate in Greenville County on a branch of South Tigris River bounded by a line running N.E. by land surveyed for Major Parsons to the N.W. by land granted to Uriah Bonner S. E. by Robert Nelson unto the other sides vacant & hath such forms and marks as appears by a plat to the said grant and said grant being duly Recorded in
