18 The following deed of Conveyance from John Barclay to James Crawford and John Craig being acknowledged before Hilary Baker Mayor of the City of Philadelphia and was presented and Recorded this 7th day of July 1798

This Indenture made the thirty first Day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven between John Barclay of the City of Philadelphia Esquire of the one part and James Crawford and John Craig both of the same City Merchants of the other part Witnesseth that he the said John Barclay for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings lawful and current money of Pennsylvania to him the said John Barclay by the said James Crawford and John Craig in hand well and true by paid

19 at or before the Execution of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and confirm unto the said James Crawford and John Craig and the survivor of them and his heirs and assigns all those ten several tracts or Parcels of Land situate lying and being in the State of Carolina one of them No 1 Containing one thousand acres situate in the District of Washington in in Greenville County on Gap Creek of the north fork of Saluda River bounded by lines running North west and North East by John Barratts Land North and North west by Wilson McKinnays South west unknown South East by Bradfords Land one other of which said tracts No 2 Containing one thousand acres surveyed for Charles Bradford the eighth day of March 1794 situate in said District of Washington in Greenville County aforesaid on the North fork of Saluda River bounded by lines running South west by Andrew Franks Land and surveyed Land South East and North west by said Bradfords North by McElwaths one other of which said tract is No 3 Containing one thousand acres surveyed for said Charles D Bradford the eighth day of March 1794 situate in the said District of Washington in the County aforesaid on the waters of Saluda River bounded by lines running South East by McKinnays Land South west by Plumbers Northwest by Henry East and West by Charles T. Bradford one other of which said tracts No 4 Containing one thousand acres surveyed for said Charles D Bradford the tenth Day of March 1794 situate in the said District of Washington in the County aforesaid on Gap Creek on the North fork of said Saluda River bounded by a line running South East by Vincent Andersons Land North East by Arthur Bonnatts North West by Charles D. Bradford one other of which said tract No 5 Containing one thousand Acres surveyed for William & John Young the 17th Day of May 1793 situate in the said District of Washington in the County aforesaid on both Sides of Fall Creek of the Middle fork of Saluda River bounded to the South East and South west by said Youngs Land North East and North west by vacant Land one other of which said tracts No 6 Containing one thousand acres surveyed for Charles D Bradford the tenth day of March 1794 situate in the said District
