a grant Bargain sell & confirm unto him the said John Burns his heirs &
Assigns forever all that tract of Land situated and lying & being bounded
in Greenville County North side of Saluda River originally surveyed for
James Blasingame & granted to him the 2^d of April Seventeen hundred
& eighty seven situate in the District of Washington S^c Carolina on the
Branches of Saluda River beginning on a small white oak on Perry's line thence
N. W. 20 twenty five Chains to S. Perry's corner on red oak thence the same
course 20 to a stake corner thence S. 80^o 46. 50 to a stake corner
