84 The following Deed of Conveyance from James Alexandria to Andrew Cooper being proven before David Goodlett Esq. by the oath of John Alexander was presented and recorded this 10th day of August 1798 This Indenture Made this first Day of May in the year our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight and in the twenty third year of American Independancy Between James Alexander Planter of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part and Andrew Cooper Carpenter of the State and County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Alexander for and Inconsideration of the sum of one Thousand Pounds Lawfull Money of the State of South Carolina to him in hand paid by the S^r Andrew Cooper at & before the sealing and Delivering of these presents (the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged) have granted bargained allined Released and Confirmed, and by these presents dotheth Grant Bargain Sell alien Release and Confirm unto the said Andrew Cooper In his actual Possession now being by Virtue of a bargain and Seal to him there made forever all that Plantation tract or Parcel of Land containing two hundred acres be the same more or less it being one half of that S^r tract of Land originally granted to William Henderson and Duly conveyed by him to the said James Alexander it being the North West half of said tract of Land Beginning at a red oak and Running S. 10 W. 63. 24. to a Stake thence S. 80 E. 31. 62. to a red oak thence N. 10 E. 63. 24. to a white oak thence N. 80 W. 31. 62. to the beginning Situate on branches

85 of Ragbuns Creek about Two Miles from the Indian boundary and hath such signs shapes and marks as the original Plat represents granted by his Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esquire Governor and Commander in chief in and over the State at Charleston the Patent Baring Date the Twenty first Day of January in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty five, and in the Ninth year of the Independancy of the United States of America ~~and~~ together with all Houses out Houses Buildings fences woods woods ways Paths passages waters Water courses Fords Lakes fishing ways and all Appertinances as well as whatsoever to the S^r Plantation Tract or Parcel of Land belonging or appertaining and the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues and profits of all and Singular the S^r Premises with their and Every of their appertinances and also all the Estat Rights Title Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever both in Law and Equity of him the S^r James Alexander of in and to the same and Every part and parcel thereof with their Appertinances to have and to hold all and Singular the S^r Plantation Tract of two Hundred Acres be the same more or less Inheritance Premises and appertinances above mentioned and all and Every Part thereof unto the S^r Andrew Cooper his heirs and assigns to the only proper use Benefit and behoof of the S^r Andrew Cooper his heirs and assigns forever and lastly James Alexander his Heirs and assigns the said Premises and every part thereof with appertinances from yielding against all persons claiming or to claim the S^r Premises by prom or under him the S^r James Alexander shall and will warrant to the said Andrew Cooper his Heirs and assigns hereby forever and forever In witness whereof the S^r James Alexander have here unto set his hand and seal the Day and year first above written Signed sealed and Delivered in presents of us
