

36 This Indenture was presented and recorded this 15<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1798. This Indenture made this 30 Day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety six of the Independancy of the United States the Twenty first Between John Rogers & Zilphia Rogers of the State of S<sup>c</sup> Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part and William Rogers of the County of State aforesaid of the other part Witness for and in consideration of the Sum of thirty two Pounds ten shillings in hand paid William Rogers hath bargained & sold and by these presents doth bargain sell & make over unto William Rogers a certain Plantation or tract of Land containing three Hundred & Eighty Acres lying in Greenville County on the Waters of Rocky Creek & Brushy Creek of Enoree River & Lorrel Creek of Reedy River Beginning on a Huory corner Running N. 40 E. to a post oak corner thence N. 50 W. to a Red oak corner from thence to the Beginning it being part of a Tract of Land containing Six Hundred and seven Acres granted unto ~~John~~ <sup>John</sup> ~~Barner~~ <sup>Barner</sup> from Under the hand of his Excellency Thomas Burchum being Dated Seventh Day of July one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eighty thousand in Grant Book of the State of S<sup>c</sup> page 258 he the said John Barner hath granted bargained & sold the above Described Tract of Land unto Moses Kemp and he the said Moses Kemp doth grant bargain & sold the above ~~tract~~ <sup>tract</sup> to John Rogers and John Rogers & Zilphia Rogers doth grant bargain sell unto William Rogers the above Described Tract of Land containing Three Hundred & Eighty Acres together with the woods Waters Hereditaments & Appurtenances unto said Land belonging or in any wise appertaining & reversions remainders or Remainders Rents Issues & profits thereof to have & to hold the granted premises of the above mentioned Tract of Land unto the said William Rogers his heirs Exec<sup>rs</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or assigns forever & yet the said John Rogers & Zilphia Rogers their heirs Exec<sup>rs</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or assigns doth covenant and agree to & with the said William Rogers his heirs Exec<sup>rs</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or assigns shall at all times hereafter peaceably & quietly possess & enjoy the said Tract of Land containing

87 The following Deed of conveyance from Sarah Tarrant to William Syres being proven before Judge Carter Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of John Barnhill was presented and recorded this 15<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1798 State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that Sarah Tarrant of Greenville County in the State aforesaid and her and her heirs bound unto William Syres of S<sup>c</sup> State of S<sup>c</sup> and County aforesaid in the Consideration Sum of forty Pounds Sterling Money to me paid by the said William Syres and the said Sarah Tarrant have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Syres all that Tract of Land containing three hundred acres situate lying and being in Greenville County upon the south & North fork of Brush Creek of Reedy River beginning at a Red oak on the side of the Creek thence N. 50 E. 44 Chain to a stake near the North fork of Brush Creek 22.6 15 Chain to a stake thence N. 7 E. 21 Chain to post oak thence N. 80 W. 100 Chain to black oak thence N. 10 W. 10 Chain to a stake thence S. 58 E. 46 Chain to Hickory thence S. 26 W. 24 Chain to a stake thence to the beginning together with all and singular the rights Members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Syres his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby Cress myself my heirs Exec<sup>rs</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> to warrant and for ever Defend and singular the said premises unto the said William Syres his heirs and assigns against my heirs and against Every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof My hand and seal this 6<sup>th</sup> Day of February in the year of our Lord 1798 and in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the independancy of the United States of America Joseph Syres John S.
