


90 The Following Deed of conveyance from Bryan W. Nowlin
 to Hewlett Sullivant being proven before Thomas Campbell Esq.
 by the oath of Joseph Dunham was presented and recorded this 30th
 Day of August 1798
 This Indenture made this thirteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred & ninety eight Between Bryan W. Nowling of the
 State of South Carolina & Greenville County of the one part & Hewlett Sullivant
 of the State and County aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that for &
 in consideration of the sum of fifty two pounds nine shillings & eight pence
 Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Hewlett Sullivant the
 Receipt whereof he does here by acknowledge and Every part & parcel thereof
 do acquit & discharge the said Hewlett Sullivant his heirs & assigns forever
 having granted sold & conveyed & confirmed and by these presents do sell con-
 vey & confirm unto the said Hewlett Sullivant his heirs & assigns forever
 one certain tract or parcel of Land lying in Greenville County on the S. W. th

91 west Side of Ruddy River containing by Estimation one hundred & twenty acres being
 part of a tract originally granted to Daniel Kruger & part of another Tract origi-
 nally granted to Alexander Farnsworth as follows to wit: Beginning on a white
 oak corner on Ruddy River & Running S. 26 E. 49 chains 50 to a Stake corner &
 thence Running W. 60 W. 10 chains 25 to a post oak corner & thence Running N. 11
 Chains 50 to a stake corner, & thence N. 6 chains to a hickory corner &
 thence Running N. 2 chains 50 to a maple corner in the branch & thence
 Running down said branch with its meanders to a maple corner at
 the mouth of said branch on Ruddy River & thence Running Down said River
 to the beginning white oak corner Together with all & singular the houses & out houses
 ways waters water courses together with all the Estate right Title Claim &
 Demand whatsoever of them the said Bryan W. Nowling in or the Name or any
 part or parcel of the Reversion & Reversion Remainder & Remainders of all
 & singular the aforesaid premises and Every of the appurtenances To have &
 to hold the said Tract of one hundred and twenty acres of Land (with the same
 more or less) and premises with their & Every of their appurtenances unto the
 said Hewlett Sullivant his heirs & assigns to their only proper use & be-
 nefit for ever free and clear from all incumbrances whatsoever and
 further the said Bryan W. Nowling for him self his heirs and assigns
 do Covenant and agree to and with the said Hewlett Sullivant his heirs
 & assigns that him with the right & Title of the said premises against
 against all persons or persons whatsoever will warrant and prove
 defend unto the said Hewlett Sullivant his heirs & assigns and last
 by the said Bryan W. Nowling do promise and agree to and with
 the said Hewlett Sullivant his heirs & assigns that they shall and will
 be ready at all times hereafter to make any Deed or Deeds or Con-
 veyances as shall be Required Requisite in the Law for the better
 securing of the right & Title of the said Land & premises unto the
 said Hewlett Sullivant his heirs & assigns or they shall Preso-
 nally; in witness whereof the said Bryan W. Nowling have here-
 unto set his hand and seal the day and date first above written
