101 This Indenture made this thirteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & Ninety Eight between Samuel Earle of Greenville County South Carolina James Hoggatt Foster & Josiah Foster both of the State & County aforesaid Witnesses that the said James Hoggatt Foster & Josiah Foster in consideration of the sum of One Hundred & Fifty Dollars to them in hand paid the receipt Whereof is here by acknowledged & With which they acknowledge themselves fully satisfied & Paid have bargain granted & sold & by these presents doth grant bargain sell Confeffe convey & confirm unto the said Samuel Earle his heirs & assigns forever all that Tract or parcel of Land lying on the East side of the Middle Fork of Main Saluda River being Part of two different Tracts of Land originally granted to David Kelly the one by his Excellency Benjamin Guad & known by the name of Kellys cane Brake the other by his Excellency Charles Pinckney Esquire beginning on a Stake on the Bank of the main Saluda River at the Mouth of a Branch below the said cane brake thence up the same Branch to a Fork thence up the left hand fork to the Head thence along a conditional line to a poplar on a branch thence along a conditional line to a Chesnut oak Joseph Wrights corner thence N. 45th west twenty eight Chains fifty Links to a Spanish Oak thence South eighty two west fifteen Chain fifty Links to a Stake in the line of the Caens Brake Tract thence ~~the~~ along the said line to Buck Eye on the Bank of the Middle Fork of Saluda River & corner of the said cane Brake thence down the Middle Meanders of the Middle fork & main Saluda to the Beginning post which said described Land the said James Hoggatt Foster & Josiah Foster doth hereby Covenant & agree for them selves their heirs and assigns to warrant & forever defend unto the said Samuel Earle his heirs and assigns from the lawfull or Just Claims of any person or persons what soever with all the appertanances belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said Land in Witness where of they have here unto set their hands & seals the day and year first above written In presents of - James H.
