of the County and State afore said and Drury Sims of the other part  
Witnesseth that they the said John Camp and Mary his wife for and  
and in consideration of the Sum of Seventy pounds Sterling to them in  
hand Paid by Drury Sims before the Sealing & Delivery of these presents  
the Receipt whereof they do here by acknowledge & themselves there  
with fully Satisfied & Paid hath Given granted Bargained Sold  
Conveyed & Confirmed and by these presents do give grant bargain  
Sell & Convey unto the Drury Sims his heirs and assigns forever  
the Following Tracts of Land lying in Greenville County on Dur  
bins Creek Beginning at a black oak on the Creek and runs thence  
South east Thirty five Chains to a white oak the South west fifty  
five Degrees Twenty five Chains to a post oak then North West  
ten Chains to a white oak then North eleven Chain to a pine then  
North west sixty degrees Thirty one Chain to a stake then North  
East Eighty three degrees Thirty Two Chain to the beginning  
which Land bearing the above Tract of Land Granted to Mary  
Murphy Beging at a pine & runs thence East thirty one Chain Sixty  
to a Red oak then South forty five Chain fifty Link to a Spanish  
oak then west fourteen Chains to a red oak then North 40 W.  
36 Chains 150 Link to a stake then North E 3/4 C. 34 Chains  
to a Stake then North E 3/4 W. 32 Chains to the beginning con  
taining one hundred and three acres be the the same more or less  
Which Land includes the plantations now in possession  
of the said John Camp & his wife Mary Camp and by them  
Sold & Conveyed to Drury Sims To have & to hold the above  
bargained Land & premises unto him the said Drury Sims  
Together all the plantations profits priviledges benefitts  
heriditaments appertanances unto the said Land belonging  
or appertaining unto the said Drury Sims his heirs or assigns for  
ever and the said John Camp & Mary his wife doth here by  
Covenant & agree to and with the said Drury Sims that they  
have a good Right full power and Law full authority to bargain  
Sell & Convey the same to him the said Drury Sims Free and clear  
of any incumbrance whatsoever and will do by Virtue of  
these presents Warrant the above Land & premises to him the

said Drury Sims his heirs or assigns against the Lawful Claim  
or our heirs or any other person or persons whatsoever saying any  
Claim Right or title to the said Land But that the said Drury Sims  
may and shall at any Time hereafter peaceably possess and enjoy  
the same In witness whereof he the said John Camp and Mary  
Camp hath here unto set or hands and Seals the day & Date first  
above Written Signed Seals and Delivered in presence of  
Samuel Howard John Wilson John Camp

The following Deed of Conveyance from William Thompson to John  
Holland being proven before Robert M'Case Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of  
Henry Chambers was presented and recorded this 27<sup>th</sup> day of September 1798  
This Indenture Made this Twenty seventh day of December in  
The year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and ninety seven  
and in the Twenty Second year of the independancy of the Uni  
ted States of America between William Thompson of the State  
of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part and  
John Holland of the County and State afore said of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said William Thompson for and in consid  
eration of the Sum of Eighty pounds Sterling Money to him in  
hand well and truly paid by the said John Holland at or before  
the Sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof  
the said William Thompson doth here by acknowledge he  
the said William Thompson hath Granted Bargained and  
Sold allined and Confirmed and by these presents doth grant  
Bargain and allien and Confirms unto the said John Holland  
his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract of Land containing  
one hundred and fifty acres more or less being part of a tract Gran  
ted to Uriah Jones by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq<sup>r</sup>  
Situate in Greenville County South Side of Enore River beginning  
on a hickory on hems branch Running up said Branch bounded  
with Land laid out for George Russell cornering again on a black  
oak Running up a little branch to a stake thence Running a South west  
Course to a hickory thence Running a South Course to a poplar  
Corner on the mery Branch thence down said mery Branch to  
where it empty into the Caen Brake branch thence the vari  
ous Courses of the branch down to a dog wood Corner thence a West  
Course to a black oak Corner thence a north Course to a pine from  
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
