Boundee Northwest ward in part by the said James Harrison Land & part by Land granted to Micajah Sinkins on the N^o East by Micajah Sinkins Land also Eight Negroes (1773) Dick Sam Anthony Joe Males, Females Hannah Joan Cla Esther together with all and Singular the rights members Hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises belonging ordinary vice Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and Singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Harrison his heirs & assigns forever and I do there by bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and Singular the said premises unto the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and against Every person who hereafter Lawfully Claiming or to Claim the same in any part Where of witness by my hand and Seal this twenty ninth day of November one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven & of the Independence of the united States of America the twenty second Signed sealed & acknowledged in the presents of Tho^s Sinkins
