

presented and recorded this 3^d Day of January D 1799.
This Indenture made this eighth day of November in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight between
Henry State of the state of North Carolina & County of Rutherford
of the one part and George Rofs of the state of South Carolina, and
County of Greenville of the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry
State for an in consideration of the sum of eighty five Dollars to him
in hand ^{pd} by the ^{3d} George Rofs the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
the the said Henry State hath bargained & sold and by these presents
doth bargain and sell unto the ^{3d} George Rofs Certain Tract or
parcel of Land containing by Estimation Sixty acres lying and
being in Greenville County on branches of Inoree River it being
a part of a tract of Land originally Granted to Peter Brooks Grant
Bearing Date the 7th of November one thousand seven hundred & 81
Eighty five beginning on a stake S 50 W. 43 Chains & 31 Links

State of South Carolina I Men all men by these presents that
John Rofs of the state of Kentucky have made ordained authorized
constituted and appointed and by these presents do make ordain
authorize constitute and appoint George Rofs of Greenville County in
the state first above mentioned, my true and Lawful attorney to
grant bargain & sell all my plantation & Tract of two Hundred
and Twenty four acres of Land on which I lately lived on Inoree
River in the County & State aforesaid Joining to Lands W Morgan
& Henry Benmons and also forme, and in my name place & stead and
in my proper act and deed, to execute Seal and deliver such Conveyances
& assurances of the said Lands to the person or persons purchasing the
said premises, as may be needful and necessary in Law and shall
be to the good liking and approbation of him or them the purchasers
as aforesaid or their Counsel learned in Law may reasonably require
giving and by these presents granting unto my said attorney full power
& absolute authority to do execute and perform any act or acts thing or things
Whatsoever that shall be necessary to be done touching or concerning
in any wise the premises or the Conveying or assigning thereof to the
said person or persons their heirs aforesaid in a full and ample
manner to all intents and purpose, as if the said John Rofs might
or could do if I was then and there personally present and also ~~with~~
ratifying and confirming all and whatsoever act and then my said
attorney shall do, or cause to be done by virtue and according to the true in-
