 Wm. Hodges being proven before Robert Cook Esq. by the oath of Epaphroditus  
 Right Over was presented and recorded this 12<sup>th</sup> day of Jan. 1799  
 This Indenture made the Nineteenth day of September in  
 the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety five  
 between William Hodges of the State of South Carolina and  
 County of Greenville of the one part and Matthew Caldwell  
 of the same State & County afore said of the other part Witness  
 that the P. Matthew Caldwell for the consideration of the  
 sum of Fifteen pounds to him in hand paid by the said William  
 Hodges & the Receipt Whereof is here by acknowledged and him  
 the said Caldwell fully satisfied therewith have given  
 granted and sold & by these presents do give grant sell and  
 confirm unto said William Hodges his Heirs & assigns for  
 ever a certain piece or tract of Land lying & being in the County  
 afore said & being on the East side of the North Fork of  
 Saluda River on Cross Creek of said River & are bounded as  
 follows Viz beginning on the said Caldwell's line running a  
 South East Course on a green line between the P. Caldwell  
 & being thence to a poplar corner a North East Course a  
 Course of Cross Creek thence along various Courses of said Creek  
 untill it strikes Benson Anderson line thence a long said line  
 to the beginning Corner containing by Estimation one  
 hundred acres to the same more or less it being tract  
 of Five Hundred & Eighty Eight acres granted unto Vinson  
 Anderson by a grant bearing date the Twelfth day of May  
 one thousand seven hundred and Ninety five and is recorded in  
 the secretaries Office in grant Book L N 5 as by Reference  
 will more fully appear & by the P. Matthew Caldwell -

The following Deed of Conveyance from Archibald Holcomb to Jesse  
 Davis being proven before Rubin Barret Esq. by the oath of Samuel  
 Nelson was presented and recorded this 12<sup>th</sup> day of January 1799  
 South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that  
 Archibald Holcomb of the state of South Carolina and County of  
 Greenville in the consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and  
 fifty Dollars to me paid by Jesse Davis of the state and County  
 afore said I granted Bargained and sold and released unto the  
 said Jesse Davis Two small Tracts of Land lying and being  
 in Greenville County and state afore said on Packs Creek of South  
 Tiger River one of them being part of a tract of Land of three  
 hundred and fifty acres Granted to Rubin Barret and by him  
 sold and conveyed unto Benjamin Ellis and by said Benjamin  
 Ellis this fifty acres conveyed to the said Archibald Holcomb the  
 other Tract Being part of a tract of Five Hundred acres of Land  
 Granted to Archibald Dill and the upper half of the said tract  
 conveyed by said Dill to James Copland and this small tract  
 of Land supposed to be Eight acres by the said Copland conveyed  
 to the said Archibald Holcomb the first mentioned Tract  
 supposed to be fifty acres Beginning on a white oak Station and
