presents that I John Ware of the County of Greenville
and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one
hundred and fifty pounds Sterling to me paid by David
Garrison of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid
Have Granted bargained, sold and Released and by these
presents do Grant Bargain, sell and Release unto David
Garrison all that part or tract of Land lying in Greenville County
on the Golden Grove Creek containing by a Survey Two hundred
and Sixty seven acres beginning on said Creek on Land Granted
to Meridith Blackburn and Running S. E. 45. 16. 50 to a
Buckeye Corner thence S. E. 30. 18 on said Blackburns
line to a white oak thence S. E. 75. 20 to a pine corner thence
S. E. 40. 39 to a Stake corner on Thompson Dukersons
Land, Thence S. E. 45. 25 to a branch which was made a Con-
ditional line between John and Samuel Ware thence down
said Creek unto its confluence with the little Grove Creek
a branch of the Golden Grove Creek from thence down said
Creek until it comister John Bowes line (and whereon
Scott and his son now lives) from thence N. W. 47. 14 to
the corner of said Bowes Land from thence S. W. 40. 39
to the Golden Grove Creek from thence up said Creek where it
