

the one part and Mycajah Stone of same County and State
of the other part Witnesseth that the said Lewis Williams
for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty eight pounds
Sterling to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof he doth
here by acknowledge he the said Lewis Williams doth Grant
Bargain, sell conveyed and confirmed and by these
presents doth Grant Bargain, sold conveyed and confirm
and by these presents doth Grant Bargain sell conveyed and
confirm unto the said Mycajah Stone his heirs and assigns
for ever a certain tract of Land containing by ~~Estimate~~
Computation one hundred Acres lie the same more or less
situate in County Aforesaid on mountain Creek Beginning
on Stone's line near the corner of an old field to Stake B) thence
South about 30-50 within 50 Links of said Creek thence
