The following deed of Conveyance from John Standford to William Roe  
being proven before Reuben Burns to beget by the oath of Hugh Wilson  
was presented and read this 29 day of April 1779  
This indenture made this 3<sup>rd</sup> Day of February in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy six between John  
Standford of Granville County in the State of South Carolina  
of the one part and William Roe of the County & State afove  
said of the other part; Witnesseth that the said William  
Roe for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy pounds the  
living money to him in hand well and truly p<sup>d</sup> by the S<sup>d</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Roe  
the Receipt whereof the said John Standford doth hereby acknow-  
ledge & for which the said John Standford hath Granted Bargained  
sold Aligned released conveyed & confirmed; and by these presents  
doth Grant Bargain sell alien Release convey and confirm  
unto the said William Roe his heirs & assigns all that plantation  
tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred acres (be the  
same more or less in his actual possession now being in  
including the plantations on which Charles Gilley  
more lives lying and being in the County and State afores<sup>d</sup>  
on branches of the S<sup>d</sup> fork of Tigua river known by the name  
of Childress Beavers dam beginning on a Maple on the S<sup>d</sup>  
Beavers dam thence N. 5. E. 30 chains to the wagon Road  
leading from Colo She mans to John Swells thence  
along S<sup>d</sup> Road to Summah Duttons upper or Back line  
thence S 5 W 815 - 60 links to beavers dam creek afove S<sup>d</sup>  
thence down the meanders of said Creek to the beginning which S<sup>d</sup>
