

228 This Indenture made this 26th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy eight Between Benjamin Nagland of the County of Greenville & State of South Carolina of the one part & John Champion of said County & State of the other part Whereas the said Benjamin Nagland has his day Bargained & sold unto John Champion a plantation or tract of Land containing two hundred & nine acres of Land it being Part of a tract originally granted to James McElroy granted by his Excellency William Moultrie bearing date the fifth day of June 1756 & recorded in Grant Book 288 conveyed from McElroy to Brook from Brook to Nagland & that such farms are marked as the plat represents also one other tract containing twenty acres more or less & bounded as follows Beginning at a stake corner of the above mentioned Land running thence nearly a south course to a Hickory corner thence a West course to a Blue oak corner thence to the upper corner of the above described Land & the said Benjamin Nagland his Heirs & Co. doth covenant & agree with the said John Champion his Heirs & Co. that he shall hereafter peaceably hold occupy possess & enjoy the above described Premises unto the said Champion & his Heirs for ever from all Bargains sales Judgments Writs & Damages & from all & every Person or Persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof & the said Benjamin Nagland & his Heirs will forever warrant & defend the above mentioned Land in the same Whereof he has hereunto set his hand & seal the day & date above written Signed in presence of

229 The following deed of conveyance from William D. Thomas to John Farmer being proven before John Thomas Junr Esqr. by the oath of Samuel Thomas was presented and recorded this 31st day of May 1799 -
South Carolina Know all men by these presents, that I William Davis Thomas of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by John Farmer of the said County the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted Bargained sold released & confirmed unto the said John Farmer in actual possession now being all that plantation or tract and part of Land on which he now lives containing two hundred acres situated in the County aforesaid on branches of Flock of South Sycamore bounded by John Mathers John Watsons and William D. Thomas' Land To have and to hold the said above mentioned tract & part of Land to the said John Farmer his Heirs and assigns forever and I the said William D. Thomas for my self my Heirs Executors Administrators unto the said John Farmer his Heirs and assigns the said two hundred acres of Land with all its premises and appertinances will warrant and forever defend by these presents In testimony whereof I the said William D. Thomas have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this sixteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine & Twenty Third of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of
