 have granted bargained and sold & released and by these  
 presents doth Grant Bargain sell and Release unto the  
 said Charles Deen all that plantation or tract of Land  
 containing one Hundred acres more or less being and  
 lying on both sides of Enore & County of Greenville  
 Beginning on a black oak thence a Crooked River &  
 corner to a ~~black oak~~ black oak thence up the River &  
 to a stake thence a Crooked River again & back back  
 & corner to a black oak thence down the River and corner  
 to a Red oak thence to the beginning corner including the  
 the Hill with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments  
 and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any  
 wise incident to the said premises to have & to hold all and  
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Charles  
 Deen his heirs and assigns forever and I do here by bind my  
 self my heirs Executors and administrators and assigns to  
 warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises  
 unto the Charles Deen his heirs and assigns against my  
 self my heirs and every other person whatsoever Lawfully

 by these that I Thomas Young of the County of Green-  
 ville & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum  
 of two hundred and Ten dollars Dollars to me paid by  
 John Byas Blackwell of the County & State aforesaid have  
 granted bargained and sold & released & by these presents do  
 bargain sell & Release unto the said John Byas Blackwell  
 a certain Tract of Land containing one hundred & forty acres  
 more or less situated in the County of Greenville Both sides  
 of Armstrongs Creek being part of a tract of Land Ori-  
 ginally Granted to Nicholas Darnal in part the other part  
 Originally Granted to said Young beginning upon a hickory  
 running North to a white oak the original line thence  
 East to a pine thence North to a hickory oak thence East  
 to a maple on the East side of said tract thence down the  
 same side of S<sup>d</sup> Creek to a stake thence East to a Red oak  
 corner thence William Newtons line to a stake thence  
 a conditional line to the beginning together with all &  
 singular the Rights members hereditaments and appertin-  
 ances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
