do hereby Grant Bargain sell & Release and by  
these presents do Grant Bargain sell and Release unto the said  
Christopher McCray all that Tract or Plantation of Land  
in bounding the Plantation said McCray now lives contain  
ing Two hundred acres ~~more or less~~ of Land situated in the  
State and County aforesaid on the south side of Enoree River  
& North side of Peters Creek Beginning on the Plank of said  
Creek on a chestnut corner and runs N 24 W 42 Chains to a  
to a Holly bush corner on Brockhorns branch then down the  
meadows of said Branch to a Cherry Tree corner on the S<sup>t</sup>  
bank of Enoree River at the mouth of said Branch then down
