

 The following deed of conveyance from Adonias Burk to Elijah
 Walker being proper before David Good to the Esq^r by the oath
 of John Blasingame was presented and recorded this 10 of June 1799
 South Carolina Washington District
 This indenture made this thirteenth day of April one
 thousand seven hundred and ninety nine Adonias Burk
 of the one part and Elijah Walker of the Golden Grove
 of the other part Witnesseth that the said Burk hath
 for the consideration of Sixty pounds Sterling paid
 down before the execution of this indenture bargained
 released and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain
 gain release and confirm unto the said Walker the
 tract of Land whereon the said Walker now lives situated
 on the Golden Grove and which tract the said Burk obtained
 from the State of South Carolina by a grant bearing date
 the fifth day of October one thousand seven hundred and
 eighty four as well appear by the said Grant now Transcribed
 & delivered with these presents to the said Walker the
 real Quantity contained in the said tract being altogether
 then unknown to the said Burk but by the same more or
 less the said Walker is to have and to hold it and every of its
 appertanances to him and his heirs and assigns forever whole
 said tract of Land the said Adonias Burk for himself
 his heirs Executors and administrators to the said Elijah
 Walker his heirs and assigns will forever warrant and
 defend as to the portion of the tract which really belonged
