 ninety eight between Thomas McGrew of Greenville
 County and State of South Carolina of the one part and
 Mape Arre Smith of the County and State aforesaid of the
 other part witnesseth that the said Thomas McGrew for
 and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars to
 him in hand paid the Receipt and payment whereof he

 presents doth Give Grant Sell and confirm unto the said Mape
 Arre Smith a certain plantation or tract of Land containing
 one hundred and thirty eight acres it being Granted to him

 sixth of April One thousand seven hundred and eighty nine
 lying and being in the County aforesaid situated on the waters
 of the South fork of Tygar river beginning on black oak
