Perdleton County; Know all men by these presents that William Rice of the County and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars paid by Jacob Philips of Abbeville County and State aforesaid have Granted Bargained Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the said Jacob Philips all that tract or parcel of Land situate in Greenwood County of said State lying and being on both sides of Little River and forming the Late Indian Boundary containing five Hundred acres of Land as appears by a plat annexed to a grant bearing date the second of April 1794 Eight and Granted to said William Rice by his Challenge Charles Pinkney recorded in Grant Book 5th Page first both same more or less together with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid mentioned by the said Jacob Philips his Heirs and assigns forever and do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jacob Philips his Heirs and assigns against myself my Heirs and assigns or any other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof as witness my hand and seal this third day of June 1799

 State of South Carolina; This Indenture made the Twenty sixth day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety nine; and in the Twenty third year of the Independence of United States of America; Between Josiah Smith of the City of Charleston in the State aforesaid Esq^r surviving Copartner of Daniel Desaupure and Edward Donell late in the lives time of the said Daniel Desaupure and Edward Donell trading under the firm of Smith Desaupure & Donell of the one part and Sarkin Tenant of Greenville County in the district of Washington in the State aforesaid Planter of the other part Whereas the said Smith Desaupure & Donell in the lives time of the said Daniel Desaupure and Edward Donell did on the the Twenty fourth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety purchase of Thomas Sance Esq^r Sheriff of Washington District the tract of Land hereinafter mentioned and more particularly described and which said tract was sold by the said Thomas Sance at Sheriff Sale by virtue of a writ of fieri facias to him directed at the suit of the said Smith Desaupure & Donell for the sum of three hundred and fifty five pounds Sterling to the said Smith Desaupure & Donell they being the highest bidders for the same; and when as the said tract of Land was then purchased for the benefit of the said firm of Smith Desaupure & Donell and become the property of the said firm now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Josiah Smith as surviving Copartner firm of Smith Desaupure & Donell do and
