The following deed of conveyance from Gilbert Sweet to William Blythe being proven before Joseph Carter by the oath of John Gandle was presented and recorded this 20th day of August 1799

Greenville County } This Indenture made this Twelfth day of August 1799 Between Gilbert Sweet of the said State and County aforesaid of the one part and William Blythe of the other part witness that the said Gilbert Sweet for the consideration of Twenty five Pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said William Blythe the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have Granted & sold unto the said William Blythe a certain Tract of Land situated in Greenville County on Brush Creek of Reddy River it being part of a tract of Land originally Granted to Musiah Chandler by his Excellency William Mouttrie Esq^r Governour over the said State Beginning at a stake up John Goodwins line & Corner to a black oak thence turn down to wards the lower line to a black oak Corner from thence to a black Oak up the old line to the beginning Containing fifty acres more or less, and the said Gilbert Sweet will warrant to him the said William Blythe his heirs &c. all that tract of Land within the above mentioned Boundaries free and Clear from any heirs. And from all and every person or persons whatsoever as witness of the same I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of August 1799 as Witness John Gandle and used the Seal of the said Gilbert Sweet
